

# Rosé 2025

## TASTING

This full-bodied, complex Rosé wine greets the taster with aromas of raspberry, pomegranate, cherries and rose petals.

The flavours dance across the palate with a swirl of black raspberries, cranberries, lime zest and Turkish Delight. Soft on the palate, but lively, completely dry and with a long, juicy finish, it has just a hint of salinity drawing you back for the next sip.

This Rosé is simply delicious by itself, yet has the body and structure to be very food-friendly. It makes a perfect pairing with barbecued chicken, summer salads with prosciutto, soft cheeses, or just a sunny day and a picnic blanket.

## WINEMAKING

All of the grapes for this wine were grown specifically for our Rosé style, and each harvested by hand when we judged them to be at optimal ripeness.

From a wine-making perspective the focus was on gentle handling of the juice and wine. In each case the fruit was destemmed and lightly crushed.

The Marquette was pressed immediately, whereas the other varieties were soaked under dry ice for 4 hours prior to pressing. The press cycle was very gentle, followed by a cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

Oxygen contact was kept to an absolute minimum. The wines were vinified separately but with early blending, followed by aging on the lees for approximately 4 months. Select lots (30%) were allowed to undergo malolactic fermentation.

The wines were not handled again prior to a gentle filtration just prior to bottling.
